- When: **Friday evening, June 19 thru Sunday, June 21, 1998**
Pig Roast, Pot Luck Supper & Court of Honor: Saturday at about 4:00 - Families invited.
- Where: Sebago Lake State Park, off Route 302, Casco, Maine
- Equipment: **Tent camping in a Public Campground.** Tent Camping, patrol cooking etc. Bring your own equipment if you have it. The troop has tents and gear; let us know if you need anything.
We will need boats and canoes - please let us know if you are able to bring either or both.
- Payment: Expected cost for the entire trip is will be **\$10 for Camping scouts.**
 For non-camping attendees of the court of honor, we are asking for **\$2/head** (payable that day) for the Pig Roast Banquet, at which we feature a roasted pig.
