

BSA TROOP 58 Trip Notice

What: **Campout in Cumberland Town Forest**
When: **Saturday, November 21 - Sunday November 22, 1998**
Saturday, Meet at the Town Forest at 3:30 PM - Home by Noon Sunday.

Where: Cumberland Town Forest
The campsite will be near the corner of the Town forest along Tuttle Road near the old RR grade crossing.

Park at the New Cumberland Town Hall on Tuttle Road and enter the trail on the left (downhill) side of the parking lot. Follow the red-blazed trail & numerous footprints approx. 1/3 mile. Turn left at sign post number four, cross the snowmobile bridge into the hayfield. Wear good boots, and *bring a flashlight for the walk home if you are not spending the night.*

An Alternate route is to walk in from Tuttle Road along the old RR grade, which is halfway between Drowne Road and the Tuttle Road crossing, just past the site of the new town hall. Just past a snowmobile bridge on the right, the old grade enters the hayfield, where we will be making camp..

On Saturday, we will make camp and hike the complete forest trail. Sunday, we will clear brush and obstacles from the trail, clip intruding branches, touch-up the blaze marks, and provide any needed maintenance to the bridges we built last year.

Equipment: Bring a tent if you have one, a lantern if you have one, something to eat on and eat with, flashlight, \$5.00, warm night clothes (expect a 30-degree night), a few pennies, sleeping bag & pad. If you need assistance with gear, let us know. Food, hot & cold drinks, and cooking equipment will be provided.

If you have a 4-wheel drive truck, let us know - we could use you to haul in some of the gear.

Payment: Expected cost for the food is \$5 per Scout.
